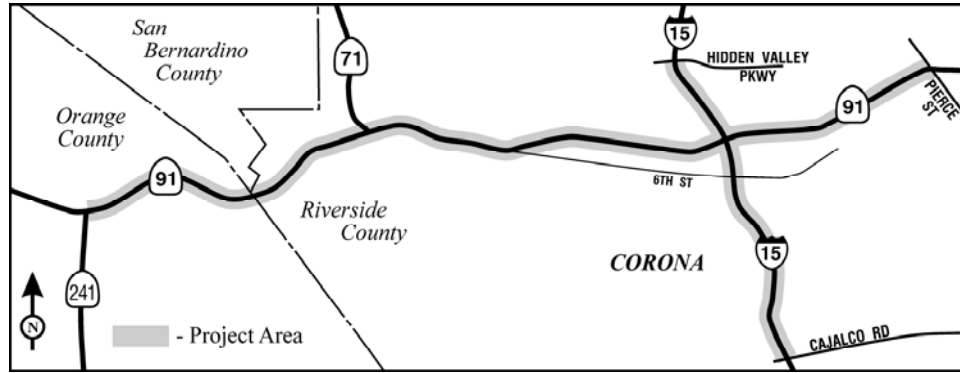




**PUBLIC NOTICE**

Announcement of Availability of the Approved  
**FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT/STATEMENT FOR  
 THE STATE ROUTE 91 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**



<p><b>WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?</b></p>	<p>The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) will be widening State Route 91 (SR-91) from the State Route 241 interchange in the Cities of Anaheim and Yorba Linda in Orange County to Pierce Street in the City of Riverside in Riverside County and Interstate 15 (I-15) in Riverside County between the Cajalco Road interchange in the City of Corona and the Hidden Valley Parkway interchange in the Cities of Corona and Norco. Major features include converting the existing high occupancy vehicle lanes on SR-91 to two tolled express lanes in each direction and express lane connectors to/from I-15 and adding one tolled express lane in each direction on I-15. On SR-91, the project also includes adding one general purpose lane in each direction and auxiliary lanes or collector-distributor roads at interchanges; modifying the existing interchange geometrics; and upgrading shoulder, lane, and buffer widths to the current State design standards.</p>
<p><b>WHY THIS AD?</b></p>	<p>Caltrans, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, and the designated National Environmental Policy Act agency, has approved the Final Environmental Impact Report/Statement (FEIR/S) for the project.</p>
<p><b>WHAT'S AVAILABLE</b></p>	<p>The FEIR/S which describes the project and the potential environmental impacts of the project is now available to the public for review and comment between August 17, 2012 and September 24, 2012. The FEIR/S is also being distributed to those persons and parties who made substantive comments on the Draft EIR/S or who requested a copy of the F EIR/S.</p>
